# Why Reading Matters

In the "From Ara's Journal" column below, you will read about my recent experience with my high school's 40 year reunion. One of the features of that reunion involved a survey sent to each class member asking a variety of questions, including who their all-time favorite teacher was. Claire Pelton came out on top. Mrs. Pelton, as we then called her, taught English. I was one of her students during my senior year. I recall that each week Mrs. Pelton had us learn 10 new vocabulary words. In fact, in some ways I think she may be the inspiration behind the "World of Words" column which closes out each issue of *Uncommon Sense*.

I interviewed Mrs. Pelton, now in her mid-80s, about a month ago and videotaped the conversation. I played that video at the reunion, and it really impacted some people. One of the things I asked her to address was why she was in the habit of having us learn new vocabulary words. She replied: "Words are strength. Words give you options that you otherwise would not have. I deliberately chose words that I thought my students would encounter in later life in order to expand the options that they'd have as adults."

I believe the same is true when it comes to reading books. The more books you read, the more options you Read have because you have been exposed to a greater number of ideas, concepts, stories, quotes, lessons, models, and cases.

Once you complete a book, the content of that book is stored in your brain for later retrieval when needed. The more books you read, the larger the repository of knowledge you have to draw upon when needed.

Reading adds to your intellectual experience. The greater the number of books completed, the greater the body of knowledge you have exposed yourself to, which has molded and influenced you, and has made you a person of experience.

I recommend you get in the habit of regular reading. Choose your books wisely, and carve out regular time to read. Highlight portions that jump out at you, and write in the margin. And teach others what you learned, which will solidify your understanding.

Do this and you will almost certainly become a leader, and others will look to you for wisdom and guidance.

## **The Elephant in the Room**

### Western Civilization is in Peril

"We urge Russia to cease its destabilizing activities in Ukraine and elsewhere, and its support for hostile regimes -- including Syria and Iran -- and to instead join the community of responsible nations in our fight against common enemies and in defense of civilization itself." -- Donald J. Trump

Let's begin by defining our terms. What is *civilization*? This word refers to the society, culture, and way of life of a particular area. It refers to the process of civilizing, as in evolving a populace out of a savage, uneducated, or unrefined state into an advanced state of human society in which a high level of culture, science, industry, and government has been reached.

What is *Western Civilization*? The term refers to a broad heritage of social norms, ethical values, traditional customs, belief systems, political systems, and specific artifacts and technologies that have their origin in Europe, but applies today with greater force to countries such as the United States and, perhaps to a lesser degree, to Australia. Western Civilization is characterized by a host of artistic (think Michelangelo), philosophic (think Aristotle), literary (think Shakespeare), religious (think Jesus Christ), and legal themes (think Moses) and traditions, including such elements as Hellenistic philosophy, humanism, the Enlightenment, and, most especially, the Judean-Christian world-view. Add to that the distinctly American ideals of unity, entrepreneurship, free market capitalism, liberty, and the preservation of a God-based society presided over by a secular government that not only is not hostile towards religion, but supportive of religion.

Western civilization is in danger of ruination. While there are outside forces that seek to destroy Western

Civilization (Islamic terrorism, for example), there are many forces within the tradition itself that seek to bring about a death by suicide.

Earlier this month, on July 6th, President Trump spoke in Poland on this very theme. The transcript can be <u>read here</u>.

Three excerpts from his speech touched on the fragile nature of Western Civilization:

"Americans, Poles, and the nations of Europe value individual freedom and sovereignty. We must work together to confront forces, whether they come from inside or out, from the South or the East, that threaten over time to undermine these values and to erase the bonds of culture, faith and tradition that make us who we are. If left unchecked, these forces will undermine our courage, sap our spirit, and weaken our will to defend ourselves and our societies."

"The fundamental question of our time is whether the West has the will to survive. Do we have the confidence in our values to defend them at any cost? Do we have enough respect for our citizens to protect our borders? Do we have the desire and the courage to preserve our civilization in the face of those who would subvert and destroy it?"

"Our own fight for the West does not begin on the battlefield -- it begins with our minds, our wills, and our souls. Today, the ties that unite our civilization are no less vital, and demand no less defense, than that bare shred of land on which the hope of Poland once totally rested. Our freedom, our civilization, and our survival depend on these bonds of history, culture, and memory."

And how did the Leftists among us react to such a speech? With predictability. They labeled such language as I have quoted above racist -- their favorite bait-

card. The Left hates America and the Left hates Western civilization, and will aid and abet any force that seeks to destroy it (including Islamic terrorists.) Thus, Peter Beinart, writing in the Atlantic, opens with this drivel: "In his speech in Poland on Thursday, Donald Trump referred 10 times to 'the West' and five times to 'our civilization.' His white nationalist supporters will understand exactly what he means." Beinart sees such wording as a sort of "dog whistle" -- code language that is meant to prop up white supremacist notions and stir up skin-heads, as if skin-heads preoccupy the mind of our current President.

Beinart goes on to opine, "*The West* is a racial and religious term. To be considered Western, a country must be largely Christian (preferably Protestant or Catholic) and largely white." Such is the jaundiced paradigm of today's Leftists. But in this they stand alone; normal human beings do not associate Western Civilization with skin color -- only Leftists do. Thus, in my view, Clarence Thomas of the U.S. Supreme Court, who is black, embodies the values of Western Civilization, while Mohammed VI, King of Morocco, who is white, does not.

Here are some of the forces that are busy trying to unravel Western Civilization:

The mainstream news media. President Donald Trump is not crying wolf when he decries the fake news that is fed to us from the mainstream media. The New York Times, CNN, the Washington Post, the Los Angeles Times, and other major and cable news outlets deliberately distort the news and often put out stories that are out-and-out fiction. (And many of them are just downright cruel.) Almost all of the major news media are simply arms for the Democratic Party and slant their news stories with the express intent of making Republicans look bad and especially making Donald Trump look as bad as possible (which, unfortunately, he often does a fine job of that himself.) Further, the mainstream media simply won't report news that doesn't fit their Leftist narrative. Thus, for those among us who form their worldview from the mainstream media, and who uncritically accept the narrative put forth by such outlets, a dark fiction blankets the minds of such persons. To put it bluntly, they believe utter nonsense and live in a fantasy world.

**Colleges and Universities.** At many American universities today, the American flag is seen as a threat that must be removed. College students have been reduced to dainty little glass figurines who learn nothing, as they flock to safe spaces where they can be supplied with coloring books, or kittens to calm their frayed nerves. Some students demand they be given no homework, and their spineless college president accommodates such nuttiness. Harvard students have been further coddled with new policies no longer penalizing them for overdue library books since their fragile sensibilities are under such immense pressure merely by being at Harvard. Trigger Warnings, Cultural Appropriation, Inclusiveness for everything but religious conservatives, and being generally offended clouds the minds of most college students at most universities today. We are raising a gang of wimps with no backbone, and these spoiled brats are soon going to enter the job market. God help us.

**The LGBTQ Movement.** This movement is not, as it claims, bent on attaining equality. They wish to destroy normalcy and replace it with something that is far removed from traditional standards of morality. Thus, some LGBTQ activists are

one shade <u>less crue</u>! than the typical ISIS fighter, held back only by the remnants of law and order that make such mayhem illegal. I am pleased they were pleased, and they demonstrated their gratitude towards me by rewarding me and my wife with an all-expense paid mini-vacation at a beach resort, presenting my wife with a large arrangement of flowers, and presenting to me a beautifully framed painting of George Washington kneeling in prayer at Valley Forge. I was moved to the point of tears. That painting now hangs in my home office directly above my desk.

Hosting this reunion taught me a number of lessons, among them the following:

- Forty years of life experience, especially from the starting point of age 18, tends to have a profound effect on a person, and take them down a path that is life-changing.
- Every person goes down a particular path, and the outcomes can be uberunique. There are people in my graduating class who flew below the radar,
  yet really made something of their lives, becoming multi-millionaires in the
  process. And there are individuals in my graduating class who were very
  visible, leaders of the first-order in high school, whom I imagined would
  become U.S. Senators or CEOs of major organizations, but who ended up in
  and out of jail, wrestling with drug addiction (something they never got near
  while in high school), and basically leading lives fraught with hardship.
- The various cliques that dominated high school life seemed to have lost their ardor, and people seemed genuinely open and accepting of everyone else.
- Quite a few people from my class are divorced, and of those who are married, most have two children.
- In terms of how we looked, some people had clearly let themselves go, and had gained quite a bit of weight. Others, had really taken care of themselves and looked fantastic. Two women come to mind here. SW was never what I would call attractive in high school, yet she was quite glamorous at the reunion, and had clearly transformed herself. KT was always on the attractive side in high school, but was now so striking, she could have appeared on the cover of a magazine! And TJ, who was relatively well-built in high school, had clearly taken care of himself in the intervening years, and was extremely strong and sculpted.
- All seemed to understand the uniqueness of the high school experience. It is very different from the college experience. Most of us grew up together, from elementary school, through junior high school, and through four years of high school, playing on the same sports teams, attending the same school dances, performing in the same musical groups, acting in the same drama productions, joining the same clubs, learning in the same classrooms, and graduating together. The high school experience bonded us together, taught us about school spirit and camaraderie, and made us players in the same formative adventure.
- Chairing this event did not enable me to enjoy it as a regular participant. I barely touched my dinner, and I hardly spoke to anyone for any length, for I was too busy managing the myriad details that had to be executed, including running the slide show and the music for the In Memoriam segment where we honored the 30 classmates who were deceased, activating the video greetings sent in by two of the most popular teachers, running the dance music, and even performing on the guitar with other musicians for some live entertainment. I missed the conversations I might have had. But I was happy to see everyone else engaged in meaningful conversation.

Not everything went as planned. The sound system, to name one example, powerful as it was, was inadequate in extending to the far reaches of the 3-room facility we were in. People at the perimeter simply could not hear what was being said from the microphone, and the din from the many conversations taking place throughout all three halls didn't help. But the overall outcome, including the gift bags, the Memory Book that I wrote and distributed, the buffet dinner, the door prizes, the memorabilia table, the music, the name tags complete with senior

portraits scanned in, and the renewing of friendships was both pleasant and satisfying. It was nice to be part of a successful event.

And yes, I'm both glad and sad it's over.
