As I reflected on the hours I spent with him, conversing with him and watching him work, I realized that Ernie is the kind of man that made the choice to be remarkable. He *decided* to get educated and to do well in school. He *decided* to master spreadsheets. He *decided* to learn how to work well with people. He *decided* to master time management and to be productive. He *decided* to get married and raise children and be a responsible and respected adult. And all this in spite of the fact that he was raised in an environment where such things were not the norm.

What decisions can you make – should you make – that could propel you to great heights? Are there self-imposed limiting beliefs about yourself that are holding you back? If so, discard them and replace them with raw determination to excel. Think about it: if you paid the price to get really good in even two or three areas of your professional life, your life could really take off. Your reputation could open doors for you. It happened to Ernie. And it can happen to you.

Do this: analyze where you are strong. Write down all the areas where you currently possess some level of skill or talent. Then figure out which of those areas could get even stronger. The Elephant in the Room

Specific Examples of the Poisoning of America

Here are some of the stories I was following just in the month of August alone. Review this list and then tell me if you think I am overreacting, or if America as we know it is living on borrowed time.



The Economy

- The Democrats passed the Schumer-Manchin bill on the promise that no one earning under \$400,000 will pay more in taxes. The Editorial Board at the Wall Street Journal examined that claim and found that due to this bill, nearly every American will see a tax increase. The Democrats lied.
- While the Department of Education within the Biden
 Administration made the claim that student loans would bring in
 more than \$100B in revenue for taxpayers, the truth is such
 loans actually <u>ended up costing taxpayers</u> nearly \$200B. How did
 this happen? Sheer incompetence. The Biden Administration
 hires mere children in adult bodies, ideologues who haven't the
 slightest grasp of how things work.

<u>Immigration</u>

 We are not even through 2022 and yet, due to the Biden Administration's open boarder policies, <u>five records</u> have already been broken this year with respect to such policies. Here are two of them: known migrant deaths stand at 609 currently, compared to 566 in all of 2021. And, from October 2021 to June 2022, the Boarder Patrol has logged some 2 million migrant encounters at the southern boarder, an all-time high. What's worse, the White House claims with a straight face that illegal aliens are *not* simply walking across the boarder and entering our country. <u>Yet they are</u>. The Biden White House is either hopelessly out of touch with reality, or they are lying brazenly.

Abortion

- A young teenage girl by the name of Grace Hartsock of Kansas was going door-to-door in her neighborhood trying to encourage voters to support a referendum on abortion law. At one particular house she approached, a radical Leftist woman started shouting at her, then proceeded to beat Grace Hartsock with her fists, hitting her in the head, and telling her "I hope you get raped!" What utter decency and civility.
- The profoundly philosophical sage Whoopie Goldberg weighed in on abortion, claiming <u>God is actually in favor</u> of it.
- And Leftist author Mary Ziegler wrote in a New York Times essay
 that even so much as recognizing the personhood of the unborn
 will harm the health of pregnant women. If you mentally
 acknowledge that the unborn is a person, a human being, the
 woman carrying that baby may all of a sudden start
 hemorrhaging.

Crime

- Anthony Evans of New York City had been arrested for violent crime some 30 times. But because he is black, and the DA in New York believes that incarcerating black criminals is racist, Mr. Evans was <u>free to commit his next crime</u> -- using a box cutter to slash an innocent 59-year-old Asian woman.
- A group of Left-wing radicals including BLM has demanded we abolish the prison system and <u>release cop killers</u>. Smart.
- A New York City sex offender attempted to murder an innocent man by sucker-punching him without warning, breaking his skull, his cheekbone, and causing his brain to bleed. And what did the authorities do to the perpetrator? They arrested him, and then they <u>immediately released him</u> without further charges.
- Democrat-run Chicago is on track for <u>6 times as many</u> carjackings as 8 years ago. And Chicago is <u>not unique</u>.
- In Yolo County, California, the "injustice" system there released 595 individuals without any bail whatsoever between 2020 and 2021, and yet 420 of them were rearrested shortly thereafter. That's 70%.
- A UN Diplomat from South Sudan was accused of raping a neighbor of his in New York City. He was <u>released without bail</u>.

- Evidently New York's justice system believes that diplomatic immunity allows diplomats to rape U.S. citizens at will.
- Los Angeles DA George Gascon <u>chose not to charge</u> a criminal in Los Angeles County. That decision resulted in the murder of an off-duty Los Angeles Police Officer.
- A Minnesota brewery has been robbed and vandalized so many times, sometimes by the same criminals, that it has to shut down early and lose business as a result, simply because the so-called Justice System there believes it is racist to incarcerate criminals. Thus, St. Paul, where this brewery is located, has a strong criminal element that roams the streets wantonly, and the police have all but given up doing their jobs.
- A bail fund that has been promoted by Vice President Kamala Harris has resulted in bail being paid from donations to allow hardened criminals out of jail to commit more crime. America
